Ask a question, save a life

“Suicide is a serious public health problem,” - David Satcher, M.D., former Surgeon General of the United States.

Goal 6 of the National Strategy for Suicide Prevention states, “Implement Training for Recognition of At-Risk Behavior and Delivery of Effective Treatment.” This includes training “key gatekeepers.” The QPR for Suicide Prevention Gatekeeper Training teaches people how to recognize suicide warning signs and how to Question, Persuade and Refer a suicidal person to a professional who can help. More than 250,000 Americans have been trained in QPR since 1999.

Like CPR, QPR is an emergency response to someone in a suicide crisis. Also, like CPR in the Chain of Survival from a life-threatening medical crisis, early recognition of warning signs, early intervention, and early professional assessment and care can save lives.

QPR Gatekeeper Training

This 60 to 90 minute training is for the general public and teaches participants the warning signs for suicide and the three-step QPR method. It is available in classroom settings from qualified instructors.
